Skirt	Smart <b>black</b> knee length or just above the knee work skirt	-Mini skirts -Bodycon skirts -Leather/Denim/Suede
Dress/Pinafore	Smart <b>plain black</b> tailored dress  Smart <b>plain black</b> pinafore <b>must</b> be worn with a blouse/shirt with a collar	-Bodycon dress -Short dress -Leather/Corduroy dress -Cut away shoulders
Trousers	Smart <b>plain black</b> tailored work trousers - <b>must</b> be worn with a blouse/shirt with a collar	-Leggings -Jeggings -Jeans
Blouse/Shirt	<b>Plain white or cream</b> blouse/shirt with a collar and sleeves  A <b>plain black</b> roll neck may also be worn	-Printed blouse -Coloured blouse -Logos -Cut-away shoulders -Crop tops
Cardigan, Jumper, Blazer	<b>Plain</b> cardigan, smart jumper or blazer (one colour) to be worn	-Logos -Sweatshirts -Multi-colours/patterns
Coat	Smart <b>black</b> coat	-Leather -Denim -Suede -Puffer jackets -Fur -Gillets
Shoes	Sensible, <b>smart black shoes</b> to be worn	-High heels -Platforms -Trainers -Canvas -Sandals/Flip Flops
Tights	Plain black or natural tights	-Patterned tights -Coloured tights
Socks	Black or White <b>ankle</b> socks can be worn with a dress, or trousers	-Coloured socks
Sports wear	Comfortable, appropriate sportswear and a pair of trainers will be required for Wellbeing & Enrichment sessions	-Strappy/vest tops -Crop tops -Plimsolls -Converse/Hi-tops

Hair	Should be a natural colour	-Bright colours
Nails/Nail Varnish	False nails may be worn but should be a <b>natural length</b> - nail varnish should be <b>one</b> colour or French manicure	-Bright colours -Patterns -Gems
Make Up	Make up may be worn but should be <b>natural</b> and discreet	- <b>False eyelashes/ Russian eyelashes</b> -Heavy make up
Jewellery	May be worn but must be <b>discreet</b> and professional	-Nose piercings -Facial piercings
